National Disaster Relief Fund: All American Red Cross disaster assistance is free, made possible by voluntary donations of time and money from the American people. The American Red Cross Disaster Relief Fund is an emergency reserve that enables the Red Cross to give immediate help to people affected by widespread disasters such as hurricanes and tornadoes and smaller disasters that occur throughout the country every day, such as fires or floods that may affect a single family or an entire region of the country.
